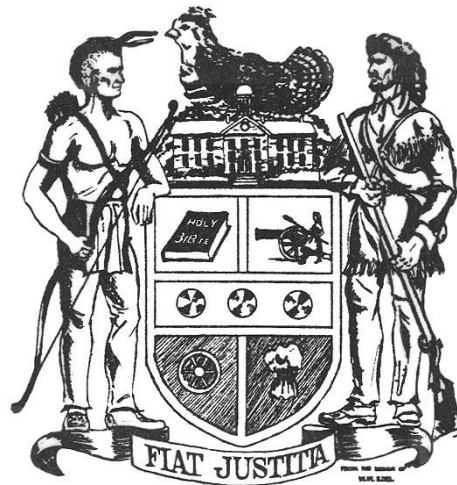

**CDBG-CV Proposed Use of Funds
BUDGET NARRATIVE
Program Year 2019 (7/1/2019 - 6/30/2020)**

1. Homeowner Utility Bill Assistance - \$63,197.00

A utility assistance program to help homeowners with utility bills that may have fallen in arrears. Homeowners would be limited to three months' worth of arrears payments.

2. Emergency Services COVID-19 Response Program - \$40,000.00

An assistance program offered to Borough of Carlisle emergency services providers who seek reimbursement of eligible costs incurred to prevent, prepare for, and in response to coronavirus.

3. Borough Pre-Application Costs - \$40,000.00

The Borough will seek reimbursement of costs incurred to prevent, prepare for, and in response to coronavirus.

4. Planning & Administration - \$15,910.00

General administration and oversight by the Redevelopment Authority of Cumberland County to implement the CDBG-CV Program on behalf of the Borough of Carlisle.

The Redevelopment Authority will present the CDBG-CV Phase II Substantial Amendment to the Carlisle Borough Council at a Public Hearing scheduled for 5:45 p.m. on August 4, 2021, just before the Borough Council's Workshop Meeting. The Public Hearing will take place via Zoom, as well as in-person in Borough Council Chambers, located in the Carlisle Borough Administration Building, 53 W. South St., Carlisle. At the public hearing, Council will discuss the proposed use of CDBG-CV Phase II funds and solicit comments from the public. Borough Council will take final action on the proposed Substantial Amendment at its regularly-scheduled Meeting on August 12, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., which will also take place in-person in Borough Council Chambers, as well as via Zoom.
